- ✓ Incorporate opportunities for equity, workforce, and jobs


Milwaukee's Programs

Milwaukee's Programs

- 70,000 LSLs
- Replacing LSLs for Five Years
- 2024: ±2,700 Replacements in All Programs
- More than 1,300 in the EPP
- 2025: 3,500 Planned with 2,300 in the EPP
- 60,000 Left at the End of 2025
- 3,500 to 4,500 Per Year Through 2037


